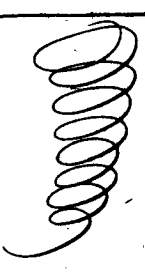

paid do hereby sell and convey unto Eli Sulgrave of Madison
County and state of Iowa the following described premises
to wit The south East quarter of the north East East quarter
of Section Twenty one "21" in Township Seventy six "76" in Range
Twenty eight in the County aforesaid And we do hereby
warrant and defend said premises against the lawful
claims of all persons whomsoever and the said Anna
Lord hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and
to the above described premises To be paid upon condition
that the said Mines Lord will pay on the first day of March
1861 his promissory note of Two hundred dollars to Eli
Sulgrave with interest at ten percent and bearing
even date with this Mortgage
