Means have or ought to have in or to the following described
Land situate in Township Number Seventy Six in Range
Twenty Nine in Town And described as follows to wit
being the west half of the North East quarter of Section
Number Eleven in Township Number Seventy Six "46" North
of Range Number Twenty Nine "29" west of the fifth
P.M. State of Iowa containing Eighty 80. acres of
Land according to the original survey and is the same
land conveyed by quit claim deed date August 23
1835 by Hapt Sherman of East Des Moines Iowa to said
Andrew J. Means and said Armstrong & Stewart
To have and to hold the premises aforesaid unto him
the said Armstrong & Stewart his heirs and
