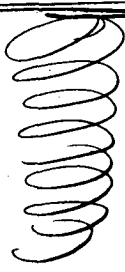

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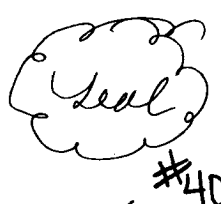


I know all men by these presents

west quarter of section Ten "10" Township No Seventy Seven "77"
North of Range No "26" Twenty six west 5 P.M. Iowa in
Madison County Iowa And the North East quarter of
the North west quarter of section No 30 Thirty in Township
No Seventy Seven "77" North of Range No Twenty five "25"
west of 5 P.M. Iowa in Warren Co Iowa And we do
hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises
against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever and
the said — hereby relinquishes all her right of dower
in and to the above described premises Signed this 22
day of March A.D. 1860
