Know all men by these presents that I Noah Quick of Lagan County Ohio in consideration of the sum of Seventy five Dollars & 75 cents in hand paid by Sylvester Fry of Licking County & State aforesaid have bargained and sold and do hereby grant and convey unto the said Sylvester Fry his heirs and assigns forever the following premises situated in the State of Iowa Madison County and being Lots No Two & Three '203' in Black No Nine '9' in the Town of Brooklyn in said State and County aforesaid to have and to hold said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Sylvester Fry his heirs and assigns forever And the said Noah Quick for himself and his heirs hereby covenant with the said Sylvester Fry and his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid that the premises are free and clear from all incumbrance whatever and that he will forever warrant and defend the same with the appurtenances unto the said Sylvester Fry his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 23rd Day of January 1860
