Clark of Madison County and State of Iowa, the following described premises to wit, Lots No two & three (2 + 3) in Block Notary ~~Iowa~~ (22) in the Town of Winterset Madison County Iowa, And we do hereby covenant with the said Francis B. Clark that we are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises that they are free from incumbrance that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons wheresoever, and the said Mary Hatchings hereby relinquishes all her right of Dower in and to the above described premises.
