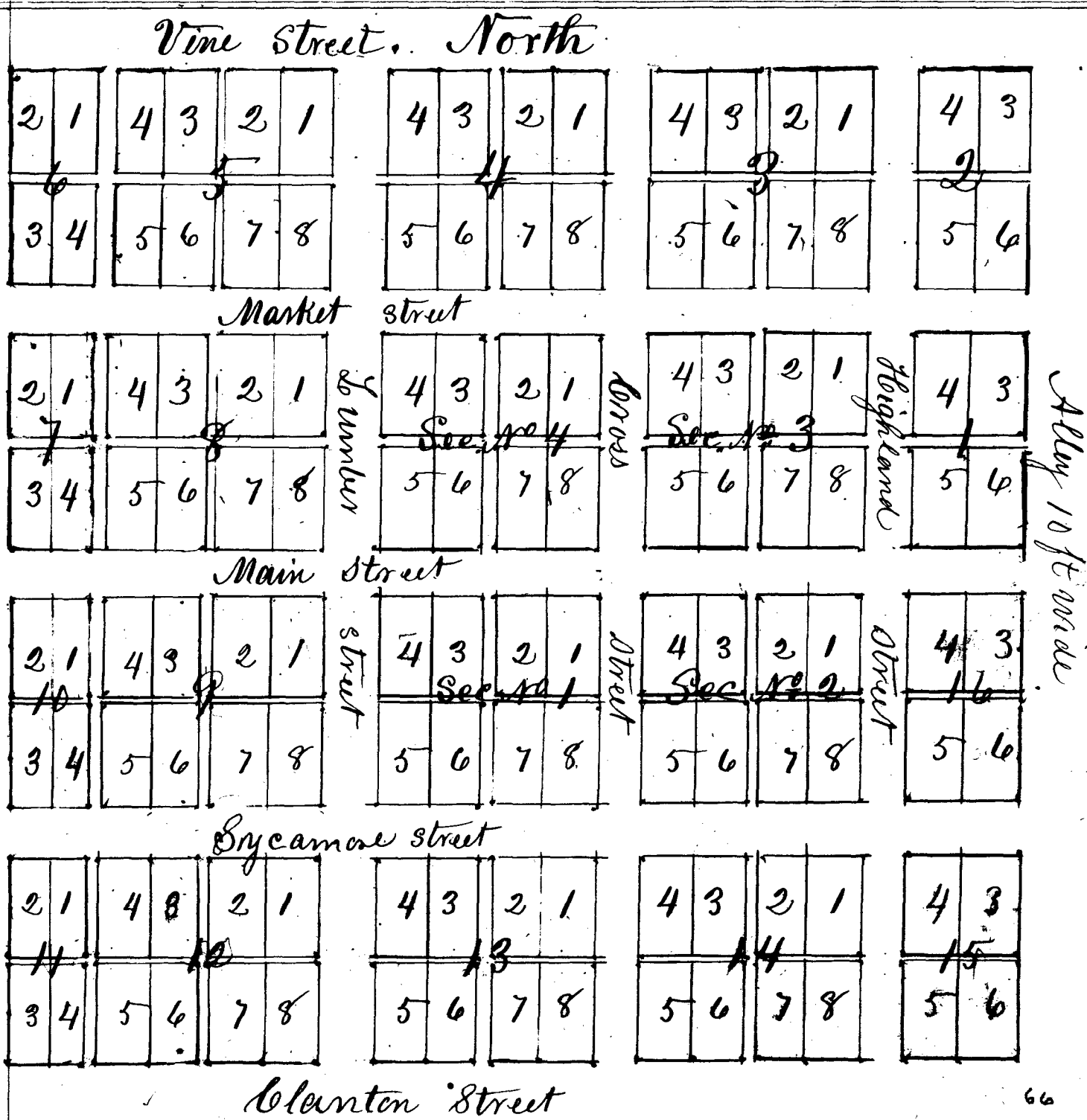


Addition to St Charles

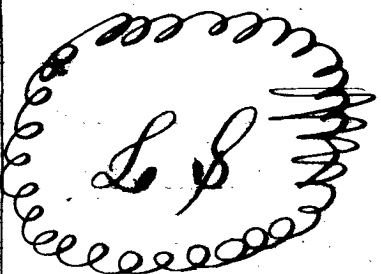
