 & Co. Miller parties of the third part witnesseth that the parties

 Lot 19 Town 99 N Range 26 (west in Madison County) The undivided  
 2/3 of the South East gr of North West gr & the North East gr of  
 the South East gr see no 28 in Town no 82 North of Range  
 no 26 west in Marion County The undivided 2/3<sup>ds</sup> of the north  
 half of the South West gr of see no Nine in Township no 72  
 N of Range no 29 west in Union City in the State of Iowa
