I, Joseph H. Abrahams and Joseph H. Mack, do know all men by these presents that we Joseph H. Abrahams and, Rebeccah Abrahams husband and wife of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by Joseph H. Mack of the County of Madison and State of Iowa do hereby sell and convey unto said Joseph H. Mack the following described Real Estate town lot As part of the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 9 one 1 1/2 Acre bounded as follows: Commencing at a point on the north line of said N.W. 1/4 Seventeen & Sixty four one hundredths rods west of the N.E. corner of the same and running thence west along said line Six rods thence south parallel to said line Sixteen and one half rods thence east parallel with said line Six rods thence north Sixteen & one half rods to the place of beginning. And we hereby further agree to warrant and defend the said title of the above described premises against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever. Signed and acknowledged this 18 day Aug 1860.
