This Indenture made this 12<sup>th</sup> Day of November AD 1861 between Samuel Hamilton Sheriff of Madison County in the State of Iowa of the first part and James Harris of the second part whereas at the fall Term of the District Court in and for the County of Madison in the State of Iowa held at the Court House on the 19<sup>th</sup> Day of September AD 1861 before the Honorable John H Gray Esq presiding Judge of said Court it was among other things ordered, adjudged and decreed by said Court in a cause therein depending between B. G. Roberts administrator of the Estate of David LeMaycraft deceased plaintiff and James Harris defend that a special execution should issue wherein the Sheriff should sell the real Estate mentioned in the petition in said action or so much thereof as should be necessary to be sold to satisfy the amount due with interest and costs in the same manner as Real Estate is sold on Execution And whereas the said Sheriff party of the first part to these presents in pursuance of the judgement order and Decree of said Court in said action and in pursuance of the Statute in such case made and provided did on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Day of November AD 1861 sell at public auction at the Court House door in the City of Winterset in said County of Madison the premises mentioned in the said order and special execution and herein after described after having given four weeks notice of the time place and terms of such Sale in the manner following First by posting a notice thereof at the Court House where the last district Court was held and one at the Post Office in said City of Winterset and one on the School House door a public place in the Township where the said real Estate is situated and by publishing a notice thereof for four consecutive weeks immediately preceding the day of Sale in the Winterset Madisonian a newspaper published in the said County of Madison and whereas at the said Sale the said premises was struck off to and purchased by James Harris at and for the sum of Two hundred forty three Dollars \$243.00 that being the highest bid therefor now therefore this indenture witnesseth that the party of the first part Sheriff as aforesaid in order to carry into effect the Sale so made in pursuance of the said

deeree of said Court and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred & Three Dollars \$243.00 to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever the following described real estate situate in the County of Madison and State of Iowa described as follows to wit The South half of the South west quarter and the North west quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Number Three & In Township number Twenty Six "96" North of Range Number Twenty Seven & West of the 6th P.M. Iowa To have and to hold the above described premises with the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof the said party of the first part Sheriff as aforesaid has hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written
