

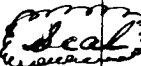

Forever, the following described tract of land situated & lying in the County of Madison State of Iowa & lying and described as follows viz, Eleven Acres to come of the North Side of the North East fractional Quarter of Section Two in Township No Seventy four (74) North of Range No twenty six (26) west, to have & to hold said premises with all the appurtenances, the said Arnold Wheeler his heirs & assigns forever & the said Henry, J. Wheeler for himself & heirs doth hereby covenant with the said Arnold Wheeler his heirs & assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid that the premises are free & clear of all Encumbrances whatsoever & that he will forever warrant & defend the same, with the appurtenances unto the said Arnold Wheeler his heirs & assigns against the lawful claim of all persons whomsoever In testimony whereof the said Henry, J. Wheeler & Mary Jane, Wheeler have herunto set their hands & seals this Ninth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight

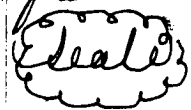
