Iowa Thence South (80) rods Thence West (20) rods Thence North (80) rods Thence East (20) rods to the place of beginning Ten acres. and we do hereby covenant with the said Joseph H Mack that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises that they are free from incumbrances that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend.

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the said premises, and appurtenances thereto, belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Mary Abrahams hereby relinquishes all her right of Power in and to the above described premises Signed the 15th day of July AD 1861
