I, George W. Howe, do hereby acknowledge and declare that I have sold to James G. Wilton, of Madison county and state of Iowa, for the sum of one hundred and eighty dollars, to me paid, do remise, release and quit claim to James G. Wilton, of Madison county and state aforesaid, the following described land lying and being in the county of Madison and state of Iowa, to-wit the North half of the North East Quarter of section twenty six (26) in Township Seventy four (74) Range Twenty Seven (27) west containing Eighty acres more or less. Witness my hand this 27<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1850.
