Ganner her heirs and assigns forever and the said George Simon for himself and heirs doth hereby covenant with the said Adelaeide H. Ganner her heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid that the premises are free and clear from all incumbrance whatsoever And that he will forever warrant and defend the same with the appurtenances unto the said Adelaeide H.
