 & White spotted & Sandy and marked as follows to wit Crocus of
 one the Rite Ear and supposed to weigh about two hundred lbs.
 Each to have and to hold the said hogs so bargained and sold to
 the said David Simpkins his Executors administrators and assigns
 to his and their only proper use benefit and behoof forever and
 I the said Oliver Morgan do hereby Covenant and agree to and
 with the said David Simpkins that I and my heirs Executors and
 administrators will warrant and forever defend the said lot of hogs
 so bargained sold and delivered to the said David Simpkins
 from and against the rightful claim of all persons whomsoever
 of all which Hogs I the said Oliver Morgan have put the said
 David Simpkins in full possession by delivering of these presents
 About the first of December next In witness whereof I the said
