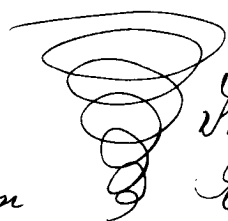

situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa to wit the
North East qr of Section Eleven 11 And Ten "10" acres off of the
South Side of the North West qr of the North West qr of Section
Twenty Seven 27 Township Seventy four 74 Range Twenty Nine 29
And the said Bensheba Pindell wife of the said Ethan A. Pindell
hereby relinquishes all right interest or claim of dower in and to
said lands and the said grantors hereby covenant to warrant
and defend the title to the said premises against the lawful
claims of all persons whomsoever Executed this 24th day of
October A.D. 1860
