McKnight of Madison County and State of Iowa the following described premises situate in said county and state to wit commencing at the south west corner of the North west Quarter 1/4 of the North west Quarter 1/4 of Section number fifteen (15) in Township number Twenty Six (26) North of Range number Twenty Eighth 28 West of 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. and running thence North Sixty (60) Rods thence East forty (40) Rods thence South Sixty (60) Rods & thence west forty (40) Rods to the place of beginning containing fifteen 1/4 acres more or less to be void upon condition that the said George W. Walverton pay or cause to be paid to the said W.W. McKnight or to his order the said sum of one hundred & thirty three & 16/100 dollars according to the time & effect of two certain promissory notes of even date herewith executed by the said George W. Walverton to the said W.W. McKnight for the sum of Sixty Six & 6/100 dollars each payable with ten per cent interest at monthly interest from the first payable six months after date and the second payable twelve months after date and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever and the said Minerva Walverton hereby relinquishes all her rights of domes in and to the above described premises signed this twenty third day of September A.D. 1861 in presence of
