Know all men by these presents that I Abraham Dudney do hereby sell and convey unto Hamford & Brother in consideration of the Sum of one hundred Dollars in hand paid the following described personal property to wit eight hogs one sandy one red the other six spotted one red cow white belly some back six years of age & one two horse wagon dove color considerably worn Said property is now on my farm in Walnut Township Madison County Iowa the above sale to subject to following consideration Whereas Said Hamford & Bro have obtained Judgement against me & one S. W. Holman as my Surety on Esq Andrews docket in Winterset. Now if I pay or cause to be paid said Judgement & cost on or before January 1st 1862 in full then this Sale to be void otherwise to be & remain in full force & effect at law & Said Hamford & Bro shall be entitled to take possession of Said property by their attys & sell the same at public outcry in Winterset & apply proceeds to payment of said Judgement after deducting expenses of said Sale witness my hand this 14 day of October AD 1861

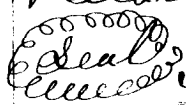
