L^eads party of the first part and in consideration of the sum of Eight
Hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by the L^eads party of the
second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and
sell unto the L^eads party of the second part his heirs and assigns
all the certain piece or parcel of land situated in the County of Madison
State of Iowa as follows to wit The South East party of the South
west quarter See Township Seventy five in Section one "1"
of Range Twenty eight containing forty acres to have and to
hold the L^eads premises with the appurtenances unto the L^eads
party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever
and the L^eads party of the first part does hereby covenant
with the L^eads party of the second part his heirs and
assigns that they are lawfully seized of the premises
aforesaid that L^eads premises are free and clear from
all incumbrance whatsoever and that they will forever
warrant and defend the same with the appurtenances
unto the L^eads party of the second part his heirs and
assigns against the lawful claims of all persons
whomsoever In witness whereof the L^eads party of the
first part have hereunto set their hands and seals
