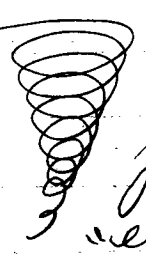

I John McLaughlin for and in Consideration of the sum of Eight hundred Dollars in hand by John Cunningham hereby sell and deliver unto the said John Cunningham the following described personal property to wit one span of bay horses geldings and one other bay horse one waggon a narrow track four cows one line buck and a white face the other three red with some white spots on near the flanks two yoke of Steers fifteen heads of hogs four calves which will be one year old in the Spring eight hundred bushels of corn four hundred Bushels of wheat Jan 14 1861
