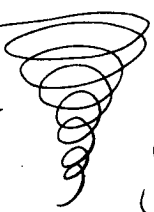

In consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars in hand paid by Lyle Launat I have bargained and sold and do hereby sell and convey to said Lyle Launat the following described goods and chattels to wit Three Black Walnut Bureaus and one Mahogany Bureau Seven Sides Pine Breakfast Tables one Dining Table Two light stands Three Crock one Leaning Eighteen headsteads one wicker chair Three Cupboards all Tools & Machinery and all lumber and stave in or about the cabinet stands owned by David Allen and learned on by L M Blank on the South West corner of the public square in Cincinnati Provided always & these presents are upon these conditions that whenever the said L M Blank has this day executed to the said Lyle Launat his promissory note for the sum of Two hundred dollars payable to him one day after date with ten percent interest from date now if the said L M Blank shall well and truly pay said sum of money according to the tenor and effect of said note to said Launat when the same shall become due then this this Instrument to be void otherwise to be in force and the right of property in and to said furniture vests in said Lyle Launat In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 5th day February AD 1868
