The State of Iowa, To all to whom these presents shall come greeting know ye that the people of the State of Iowa in the name and by the authority of the people of said State do Commission him Nolany Public within and for the County of Madison in the State of Iowa and do authorize empower and require him to execute and fulfil the duties of that office according to law and to have and to hold the said office with all the rights authorities privileges and emoluments thereto lawfully appertaining for the term of three years unless sooner revoked by the Governor In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be affixed the Great Seal of the State of Iowa Done at Des Moines this 21st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty one of the Independence of the United State of the Seal Eighty fifth and of this State the fifteenth
