 purchased by the said Joseph Davis. ^{now} Know Ye That the United States
 of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with
 the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have
 given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said
 Joseph Davis and to his heirs the said tract above described to have
 and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities
 and appurtenances of whatever nature hereunto belonging unto the said
 Joseph Davis and to his heirs and assigns forever In testimony where-
 of I Franklin Pierce President of the United State of America have
 caused these letters to be made patent and the Seal of the general
 Land office to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand and
 at the City of Washington the Third day of June in the year of our
 Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty six and of the
 Independence of the United State the eighteenth by the President
 Franklin Pierce
