that the said party of the first part in consideration
of the sum of seventy seven dollars and eighty five cents
with grant and sell to the party of the second part
his heirs and assigns all of the following real Estate
to wit the East half of the South West fourth
of Section No Twenty Nine in Township No Seventy
four North of Range No Twenty Eight W together
with all the hereditaments and appurtenances
thereto unto belonging or in anywise appertaining
this conveyance is intended, as in Mortgage to
secure the of the sum of sixty seven dollars and
eighty five cts with annual interest according to
the conditions of a certain Note dated this day
and executed by the said T. J. Moon to the said party of
the second part and these presents shall be void if
such payment be made but in case default shall be
made in the payment of the principal or interest as
above provided then the party of the second part his
executors and assigns are hereby empowered to sell
the premises above described with all the appurtenances
in the manner prescribed by law and out of the money
arising from such sale to retain the said principal and interest
together with the costs and charges of making sale and
