Whereas Orman Lee of Port Washington
 County of Ozaukee State of Wisconsin did
 die on the 2 day of March AD 1838

obtain Letters Patent of the United States of America on certain
 improvements in a Harrow called the rotary cutting Harrow secured
 to him his heirs and assigns the exclusive right of constructing
 using said improvement and selling to others the right to do the
 same in the United States of America a description whereof is
 given in the Specifications annexed to said Letters Patent And
 whereas the said Orman Lee did on the fourth day of
 August AD 1839 by an instrument in writing under his hands and
 seal duly executed and delivered assign sell and convey to
 John Robinson of the County of Olmsted State of Minnesota and
 to his heirs and assigns the right of constructing making
 and using said improvement and of selling to others the right to
 do so within the Territory to wit the whole of the State of Iowa
 and not elsewhere to the full end of the term for which said
 Letters Patent were granted as fully and intirely as the same
 would have been enjoyed by the said Orman Lee had not
 such assignment and sale not have been made And whereas the
 said John Robinson of the County of Olmsted State of Minnesota
 did on the 21st day of May AD 1860 by an instrument in
 writing under his hands and seal duly executed and
 delivered assign sell and convey to J M Leonard and
 William B Pallen of the City and County of La Crosse State
 of Wisconsin to their heirs and assigns the exclusive
 right of making and using said improvement and of
 selling to others the right to do in the Territory to wit the
 whole of the South half of the State of Iowa and not else-
 where for the full end of the term for which said Letters
 Patent are granted as fully and intirely as the same would
 have been enjoyed by the said Robinson or Lee had such
 assignment and sale not have been made And whereas
 E M Guckenson of the County of Madison State of Iowa is
 desirous of acquiring an interest in said improvement
 Now this indenture witnesses that for and in consideration of
 the sum of Five hundred Dollars to us in hand paid
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we have assigned
 sold and conveyed and do hereby assign sell and convey

To the said S. M. Guiberson to his heirs and assigns the right of
Constructing and using said improvement and of selling to others the
right to do in the Territory to wit the whole of the County of Madison
Clark & Union State of Iowa, and in no other place or places to
the full and of the term for which said letters were granted as
fully and entirely as the same would have been enjoyed by ~~the~~ us
had such assignment and sale not have been made in testimony
whereof we have hereto set our hands and seals this twenty ninth
day of August One Thousand Eight hundred and sixty
