Court it was among other things ordered adjudged and  
decreed by said Court in a cause therein depending betw  
ween Lee Murphy and Avery, <sup>respectfully and</sup> Matthew Rumbaugh & W.C.  
Jenkins defendants that a special execution should issue  
whereon the Sheriff should sell the real estate mentioned
