covenant with the said Joseph L. Williams that I am lawfully
seized in fee simple of said premises that they are free from incum-
brance that I have good right and lawful authority to sell the
same and I do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said
premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful
claims of all persons whomsoever Signed the Thirteenth day of
