 do hereby covenant with the said Solomon Hackett that we

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and lawfully seized of said premises that they are free from incumbrance that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the title to the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever signed this 12th of September 1861
