 with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatever
 nature thereto pertaining unto the said Simeon A. Bagley and to his heirs and
 assigns forever In testimony whereof I Franklin Pierce President of
 the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made
 patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
