This indenture witnesseth that we Thomas Munkle

County in the State of Iowa, in consideration of a
common duty & respect for mankind have this day
created, conveyed, and forever quitclaimed to John

Munkle Eliska Miller & Henry Grater of the county and state aforesaid
and their successors as trustees of the premises hereby conveyed, and to
be known and used as a common burying ground, lying and being in
in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, and bounded as follows:
Town Commencing on the line extending East & West through the middle of
Fractional Section Seven in Township No Seventy five North of Range No
Twenty six West at a point bearing North Eighty five degrees East
five hundred & fifty links thence South Seventy one links thence
North Eighty five degrees East three hundred links thence North
three hundred and seventy one links thence South eighty five degrees
West three hundred links thence South three hundred links to the
place of beginning containing one acre and eighteen rods and eight
one hundredths of a rod, to have & to hold the land described, as above
and to be used as aforesaid. In witness whereof the said Thomas Munkle
Menes le Debond, and Mary Debond, wife of the said Menes le Debond,
in relinquishment of her interest and right to sever in the premises
aforesaid, have hereunto set their hands and seal the eleventh
day of May 1862.
