 District Court of
 Madison County, State
 of Iowa by the clerk
 of said Court tested

the 27th day of May A.D. 1859 directed and delivered to the
 Sheriff of said County J. H. Evans in a certain cause wherein
 James M. Cullock was Plaintiff and B. H. Morry was
 defendant against the goods and chattels lands and
 tenements of the said B. H. Morry for want of sufficient per-
 sonal property wherewith to satisfy the amount and
 costs the said Sheriff J. H. Evans did seize and lay upon
 on the 27th day of May A.D. 1859 on all the state right title
 and interest which the said B. H. Morry had on the 27th
 day of May A.D. 1859 or any time afterwards or now has
 in and to the following described property to wit The North
 East quarter of the North East 2 quarter of section thirty
 five in Township Seventy Four Range Twenty nine
 Madison County Iowa And after having advertised the said
 property for sale for four weeks immediately preceding the
 day of sale herein after mentioned in the Winter set Mad-
 isonian news paper published in the City of Winter set
 Iowa and by notices of the same posted in three public places
 in said County of Madison one of which places being in the
 same Township in which said property is situated and
 one being on the front door of the Court House in said
 City of Winter set the place where the last District Court
 of said Madison County was held as required by law
 did on the 2d day of July A.D. 1859 between the hours of
 9 o'clock in the forenoon and 4 o'clock in the afternoon
 of that day proceed to sell the said property after
 having first exposed the same for sale at public
 auction at the front door of the Court House of said
 and did then and there strike off the said property to the said
 James M. Cullock the said Plaintiff for the amount due
 on said Execution including costs to wit for the sum
 of one Hundred & Seventy Seven dollars & 3/100
 the said James M. Cullock being the highest

bidder and the said sum of \$177 ^{3/4} being the highest and
 best sum bid therefor for the particular of the foregoing
 under the official act of my predecessor in Office J. W. Evans
 reference is made to the said execution now on file in the office
 of the clerk of ^{said} district Court said sale having been made
 by the said J. W. Evans at that time Sheriff as aforesaid
 Now therefore know ye that I Samuel Hamilton the Sheriff
 of the County of Madison State of Iowa by virtue of said the
 writ of Execution and of the Statutes in such case made and
 provided in consideration of the said sum of One Hundred &
 Seventy Seven & ^{3/4} Dollars Dollars in hand paid by the
 said James McCulloch to the said J. W. Evans Sheriff as aforesaid
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged reference being
 had to said Execution & the return of said J. W. Evans Sheriff
 Thereby have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
 James McCulloch His heirs and assigns forever all the
 Estate right title and interest which the said J. H.
 Murry had on the 2^d day of July A.D. 1859 or at any time
 afterwards or now have in and to all the above mentioned
 property to have and to hold the said property and every part
 thereof unto the said James McCulloch His heirs and
 assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said
 Samuel Hamilton Sheriff aforesaid and under
 the authority aforesaid might could or ought to see
 and convey the same. In witness whereof I have
