Louisiana in consideration of the sum of one hundred & Seventy two & $\frac{75}{100}$ Dollars in hand paid do hereby sell and convey unto Alby Lerry of Madison County and State of Louisiana the following described Real Estate situated in the County of Madison and State of Louisiana to wit: the West half of the North West quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South West quarter of Section Number Twenty Six Township Number Seventy Six North of Range Twenty Seven West with the exception of five acres on the North End of said West half containing fifteen acres or less And the said grantor hereby covenants to warrant and defend the title to the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever Assented this 5th day of November A.D. 1862
