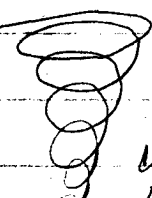

 State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged have bargained & sold & by these presents do
 sell & convey unto the said Obispo the

described personal property to wit Low Yoke of Oxen
described as follows One Red & White Spotted Ox of the
value of Twenty Seven ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars One Black Ox of the
value of Twenty Seven ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars One Yoke of Red Oxen
of the value of fifty five Dollars to have and to hold
the same forever and well forever warrant & defend the
same against the lawful claims of all persons whom
soever Upon Condition however that if the said G. & Calvin
Palmer shall pay or cause to be paid when due a certain
promissory note given to the said G. & Calvin by us and ^{of even date with} calling for
the sum of fifty five Dollars of even date herewith and payable
when the said G. & Calvin Palmer shall arrive in Denver
city & in case said Palmer neglect or fail to start to Denver
city then said note is due in sixty days from the date
whereof and it is agreed between the parties that the said
Palmer agree to keep possession of the Oxen until said
note is due Witness our hands this 19 day of April
AD 1862
