Moody the following described personal property heretofore owned by me and now in my possession to wit one filly three years old this spring of a dark bay color one filly two years old this spring of a bright bay color one gelding supposed to be nine years old of a gray color & one Mare supposed to be nine years old of a bay color and I warrant the title to the said property against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. The foregoing sale and conveyance to be void upon condition that I pay on account to be paid to the said J. W. Moody or to his assigns the amount in full of principal interest and costs and attorney & assessed interest and costs of a judgment which the said J. W. Moody obtained against me in the District Court of Madison County Tennessee on the 3 day of April A.D. 1862 being at the Spring Term of said Court in said year for the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars & costs of suit taxed to eighty seven dollars & sixty cents drawing interest at the rate of six percent per annum within eight months from the date hereof otherwise to be & remain in full force & effect in law as an absolute sale conveyance of said property in witness whereof
