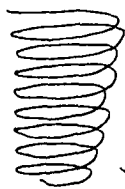

This deed of Bargain and Sell made and executed the 26 day of May A.D. 1858 by and between James H. Meiles & Harriett Meiles

his wife of the County of Clinton and State of Iowa party of the first part and Judson Clark of the same residence of the second part witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred Dollars to them paid by the said party of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have granted, sold, and do by these presents grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the certain tract or parcel of Real Estate situated in the County of Madison State of Iowa to wit South half of South West quarter of Section No 5 five N.E. 1/4 of the North West quarter of Section No Eight & in Township Seventy four 74 of Range Twenty Eight Situate in the County of Madison State aforesaid to have and to hold the premises above described with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said second party and to his heirs and assigns forever The said Jas H. Meiles hereby covenanting for himself his executors and administrators that the above described premises are free from any incumbrance that he has full right power and authority to sell the same and he will warrant and defend the title unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against the claims of all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same and the said Harriett Meiles wife of the said James H. Meiles hereby releases and relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the foregoing described premises In witness whereof the said parties of the first part have hereunto set their
