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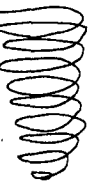

issued out of the District Court of Madison State of Iowa, by the Clerk of said Court. Bested the — day of — A.D. 1860 to me directed and delivered in a certain cause wherein E. M. Guckenson is plaintiff and William Belk is defendant against the goods and chattels lands and tenements of the said William Belk for want of sufficient personal property whereunto to satisfy the amount and costs I did seize and levy upon on the — day of — A.D. 1860 on all the estate right title and interest which the said William Belk had on the 4th day of March A.D. 1861 or any time afterwards or now has in and to the following described property to wit the North West q^r of the North West q^r of Section 36 Twenty 30 in Township 36 Seventy for 74 North of Range 36 Twenty Eight 26 West of the 5th P. M. Iowa And after having advertised the said property for sale for four weeks immediately preceding the day of sale hereinafter mentioned in the Winterst Madisonian newspaper published in the City of Winterst Iowa and by notices of the same posted in three public places in said County of Madison one of which places being in the same Township in which said property is situated and one being on the front door of the Court House in said City of Winterst the place where the last District Court of said Madison County was held as required by Law did on the 27 day of July A.D. 1861 between the hours of 9 o'clock in the forenoon and 4 o'clock in the afternoon of that day proceeded to sell the said property after having first exposed the same for sale at public auction at the front door of the Court House aforesaid and did then and there strike off the said property to W. W. McKnight for the sum of forty eight dollars \$48.00 the said W. W. McKnight being the highest bidder and forty eight dollars \$48.00 being the highest and best sum bid therefor And I certify that said sale was in all things fairly and honestly conducted without any fraud or deceit whatever. I do therefore know ye that I Samuel Hammetton the Sheriff of the County of Madison State of Iowa by virtue of said the writ of General Execution and of the Statutes in such case made and provided in consideration of the sum of forty eight dollars \$48.00 to me in hand paid by the said W. W. McKnight the receipt whereof is

heretofore acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and conveyed and
 by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said W. W.
 McKnight his heirs and assigns forever all of the estate rights title
 and interest which the said William Belk had on the 4th day of
 March A.D. 1861 or at any time afterwards or now have in and
 to all the above mentioned property to have and to hold the said
 property and every part thereof unto the said W. W. McKnight his
 heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said
 Samuel Hamilton Sheriff aforesaid and under the authority
 aforesaid might could or ought to sell and convey the same In
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this first day
