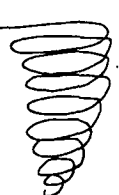


W. M. Knowlton

State of Iowa in consideration of the sum

of Fifty Dollars in hand paid, we hereby sell and convey unto
W. Y. Wallace of Madison County and State of Iowa, the
following described premises to wit the South 1/2 halves of Lots
No Three 3 & Four 4 in Block No Thirty Four in the original
Town plot of Winterset, Meeker County Iowa and I do
hereby covenant with the said W. Y. Wallace that lawfully
eigned in fee simple of said premises that they are free from
incumbrance that I have good right and lawful authority
to sell the same and I do hereby covenant to warrant and
defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging
against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever
Signed the fifth day of September A.D. 1882
