To all to whom these presents shall come greeting: Know ye that in pursuance of an act of Congress entitled an act to raise for a limited an additional military force and for other purposes approved February 11th 1847 Henry Connolly private Captain Bragg's company third regiment United States Artillery having deposited in general land office a warrant in his favor number 69279 There is therefore granted by the United States unto Francis A Cunningham assignee of said Henry Connolly and to his heirs the North West quarter of Section fourteen in Township Seventy Seven North of Range Twenty six west in the district of lands subject to sale at Lower City Iowa containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General land office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned warrant in pursuance of the act of Congress above mentioned approved February 11th 1847. To have and to hold the said part of said Section of land with the appertinances thereof unto the said Francis A Cunningham and to his heirs and assigns
