 To all whom these presents shall come greeting:
 Know ye that in pursuance of an act
 of congress entitled an act to raise for a limited time an
 additional military force and for other purposes approved
 February 11th 1847. John Flanigan private in captain Briggs
 company third regiment United States Artillery having
 deposited in the general land office a warrant in his favor
 numbered 71168. There is therefore granted by the United States
 unto Francis A Cunningham assignee of said John
 Flanigan and to his heirs the North East quarter of section
 fourteen in Township Seventh South North of Range twenty six
 West in the District of lands subject to sale at Iowa City Iowa
 containing One Hundred and sixty acres, according to
 the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the
 general land office by the Surveyor general which said tract
 has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned war-
 rant in pursuance of the act of congress above mentioned
 approved February 11th 1847. To have and to hold the said
 part of said section of land with the appurtenances thereof
 unto the said Francis A Cunningham and to his heirs
 and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Franklin Pierce
 President of the United States of America have caused these
 letters Patent and the seal of the general land office to be
 hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the City
 of Washington the first day of November in the
 year of Our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and

fifty three and of the independence of the United States
the Seventy eighth
