To all to whom these presents shall come greeting
Know ye that in pursuance of an act

of Congress entitled an act to raise for a limited time an
additional ^{military} force and for other purposes approved February
11th 1847. Johnathan E. Dickinson corporal in Captains
Curtis company first regiment United States Dra-
goons having deposited in the general land office a
warrant in his favor number 71270 There is therefore
granted by the United States unto Francis A. Cunnin-
gham assignee of said Johnathan E. Dickinson and his
heirs the South East quarter of Section fourteen in
Township Twenty Seven North of range twenty six
west in the district of lands subject to sale at
Sewel City Iowa containing one hundred and sixty
acres - according to the official plat of the survey
of the said land returned to the general land office
by the surveyor General which said tract has been located
in satisfaction of the above mentioned warrant in pursuance
of the act of congress above mentioned approved February 11th 1847.
To have and to hold the said part of said section of land with the
appurtenances thereof unto the said Francis A. Cunningham
and his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof
J. Franklin Pierce President of the United States of America
have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal
of the General land office to be hereunto affixed Given under
my hand at the City of Washington the first day of November
in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty
three and of the Independence of the United States the twenty
eighth
