

Twenty five Dollars in hand paid by Basel Greenwood of the County  
of Madison have bargained and sold unto hereby grant bargained  
and convey unto the said Basel Greenwood and his heirs and  
assigns forever the following premises situated in the County of  
Madison in said State and bounded and described as follows  
to wit the South East quarter of the North West quarter of  
Section fifteen 15 in Township Seventy Six North of Range

Twenty Six west P.M. I have and to hold said premises with  
 the appurtenances unto the said Basel Greenwood and his heirs and  
 assigns forever and the said Willis Leamie for himself and his  
 heirs with hereby covenant with said Basel Greenwood and his  
 heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises; aforesaid  
 that the premises are free and clear from all incumbrances whatsoever  
 and that he will forever warrant and defend the same with the  
 appurtenances unto the said Basel Greenwood and his heirs and assigns  
 against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever and the said  
 Malinda Leamie hereby relinquishes all her right and claim of  
 dower in and to said premises In testimony whereof the said Willis  
 Leamie and Malinda Leamie his wife have hereunto set their  
 hands and seals this the fourth day of December in the year of our  
 Lordes one thousand eight hundred and fifty two

 Warren County  peace personally appeared the above named,  
 Willis Leamie and Malinda Leamie his wife personally known to  
 me to be the persons whose names are subscribed to the aforesaid  
 deeds as parties thereto and acknowledged the signing and sealing  
 of the above conveyance to be their voluntary act and deed and  
 the said Malinda Leamie his wife being at the same time examined  
 by me separate and apart from her said husband and the contents  
 of said conveyance made known to her by me she then declared  
 that she did freely execute sign and seal the same and relinquish  
 her dower in said premises without compulsion or undue  
 influence of her said husband and that she is still satisfied  
 therewith this the fourth day of December AD 1852
