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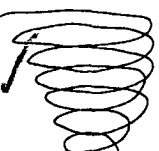

 heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises; aforesaid
 that the premises are free and clear from all incumbrances whatsoever
 and that he will forever warrant and defend the same with the
 appurtenances unto the said Basil Greenwood and his heirs and assigns
 against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever and the said
 Matilda Council hereby relinquishes all her right and claim of
 dower in and to said premises in testimony whereof the said Willis
 Council and Matilda Council his wife have hereunto set their
 hands and seals this the fourth day of December in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two

 her dower in said premises without compulsion or undue
 influence of her said husband and that she is still satisfied
 therewith this the fourth day of December A.D. 1852
