



State of Iowa for the use of the School

funds vs. S. B. Guberson. By virtue of a writ of Special
Execution issued out of the District Court of Madison &
State of Iowa by the bench of said Court Dated the 25th
day of September Ad 1863 to me directed and delivered in a
certain cause wherein the State of Iowa for the use of the
School Funds of Madison County Plaintiffs and S. B.
Guberson defendant against the goods and chattels lands
and Tenements of the said S. B. Guberson for want of

Sufficient personal property wherewith to satisfy the amount and costs
 I did seize and levy upon on the 30th day of September AD 1863 on all
 the estate right title and interest which the said S. B. Gubenson had on the
 30th day of September AD 1863 or at any time afterwards or now has
 in and to the following described property to wit the North West q^r
 of the South West q^r of Section Number Four 4 in Township Number
 Seventy five 75 North of Range No Twenty eight 28 west of the 5th
 P.M. Range Area after having advertised the said property for sale
 for four weeks immediately preceding the day of sale hereinafter
 mentioned in the *New York Delay* a Newspaper published in the City
 of Winterset Iowa and by notices of the same posted in three public
 places in said County of Madison one of which places being in
 the same Township in which said property is situated and one
 being on the front door of the Court House in said City of
 Winterset the place where the last district Court of said
 Madison County was held as required by law did on the 3rd
 day of November AD 1863 between the hours of 9 o'clock in the
 forenoon and 4 o'clock in the afternoon of that day proceeded to
 sell the said property after having first exposed the same for
 sale at public auction at the front door of the Court House
 aforesaid and did then and there strike off the said property
 to S. B. Ruby for the sum of Eighty Two Dollars \$82.00
 the said S. B. Ruby being the highest bidder and Eighty
 Dollars \$82.00 being the highest and best sum bid therefor
 I do therefore know ye that I Samuel Hamilton the Sheriff
 of the County of Madison State of Iowa by virtue of the said
 writ of Special Execution and of the Statutes in such case
 made and provided in consideration of the said sum of
 Eighty Two Dollars \$82.00 to me in hand paid by the
 said S. B. Ruby the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
 S. B. Ruby his heirs and assigns forever all of the estate
 right title and interest which the said S. B. Gubenson
 had on the 30th day of September AD 1863 or at anytime
 afterwards or now have in and to all the above mentioned
 property to have and to hold the said property and every
 part thereof unto the said S. B. Ruby his heirs and assigns
 forever as fully and absolutely as I the said Samuel Hamilton
 Sheriff aforesaid and under the authority aforesaid

Might could or ought to sell and convey the same In Witness
