Whereas Andrew Miller of Madison County Iowa has deposited
in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of
the Register of the Land Office at Fort Des Moines whereby
it appears that full payment has been made by the said
Andrew Miller according to the provisions of the act of
Congress of the 24 of April 1820 entitled an act making
further provisions for the sale of the public lands for the
West fractional half of the South East quarter of Section
Thirty one in Township Seventy Six North of Range
Twenty Six West in the District of lands subject to sale
at Fort Des Moines Iowa containing one hundred and
thirty one acres and forty nine hundredths of an acre
according to the official plat of the Surveyor of said lands
returned to the general land office by the Surveyor General
which said tract has been purchased by the said Andrew
Miller now know ye that the United States of America
in consideration of the premises and in conformity with
the General acts of Congress in such case made and

Provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Andrew Miller and to his heirs the said tract above described, to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Andrew Miller and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Franklin Pierce President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five and of the Independence of the United States the Seventy Sixth.
