

the sum of four hundred dollars in hand paid as hereby Sell and
convey unto H. W. Handy of Madison county and State of Iowa
the following described premises to wit Commencing at a point eight
Rods East of the North west corner of a certain four acre tract
out of the South East corner of the west half of the South East
quarter of Section Thirty Six Township Seventy Six Range Twenty
Eight Madison county Iowa Running thence South Eight Rods
thence East Eight Rods thence North Eight Rods thence west
Eight Rods to the place of Beginning and we as hereby covenant
to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful
claims of all persons whomsoever and the said Lewis Ketch
hereby relinquishes all her right of claim in and to the above
described premises Signed this 7th day of October 1863
