

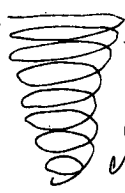

 more or less and the said grantors hereby covenant to warrant
 and defend the title to the said premises against the lawful claims
 of all persons whomsoever executed this 20 day of November A.D.
