This indenture made the 20th day of October AD 1863  
 between Minor Ford of Madison County Iowa of the  
 first part and John P. Nichols of the same place of  
 the second part, witnesseth that the said party of  
 the first part in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to  
 him paid by the said party of the second part at or before the sealing and  
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted  
 bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell to  
 said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever South east  
 quarter (1/4) of the North east quarter (1/4) of section twenty one (21) Township seventy six  
 (76) and Range twenty eight (28), And also all the estate and right of  
 dower property and possession as well in law as in equity of the said party  
 of the first part of in or to the above described premises And every part and  
 parcel thereof with the appurtenances, to have and to hold all and singular  
 the above mentioned and described premises together with the appurtenances  
 unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, And the said  
 Minor Ford for himself and his heirs <sup>but</sup> the said premises in the quiet and  
 peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns  
 against the said party of the first part and his heirs and against  
 all and every person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same, I shall and will warrant and by these forever defend
