The United States of America to all to whom these presents shall come Greeting, Whereas James Johnson of Madison County Iowa has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Chautau whereby

it appears that full payment has been made by the said James Johnson according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th day of April 1820 entitled an "act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" for the North half of the North east quarter of section nineteen in Township Twenty five North, of range twenty six West, in the district of lands subject to sale at Chautau Iowa containing eighty Acres. According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said James Johnson, Now Know Ye, that the United States of America, in Consideration of the premises And in Conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such Cases made and provided has given and granted And by these presents do give and grant unto the said James Johnson And to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the right privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said James Johnson And to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof I Franklin Pierce, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, And the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed,

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the first day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three. And of the Independence of the United States the seventy-eighth.
