By virtue of a writ of Special Execution issued out of the District Court of Madison County, State of Iowa, by the Clerk of said Court, dated the 15th day of June, A. D., 1864, to me directed and delivered, in a certain case wherein State of Iowa for the use of the School funds of Madison County is Plaintiff and Mr. D. Martin is Defendant, against the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of the said Mr. D. Martin for want of sufficient personal property wherewith to satisfy the amount and costs, & did seize and lay upon on the sixteenth day of June, A. D., 1864, on all the estate, right, title and interest which the said Mr. D. Martin had on the 5th day of April, A. D., 1864, or at any time afterwards, or now has in and to the following described property, to wit: The north east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the south west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section No. three (3) Township No. seventy four (74) Range No. twenty eight (28) west of the 5th P. M., Iowa. And, after having advertised the said property for sale for four weeks immediately preceding the day of sale hereinafter mentioned in

the Hawkeye Flag, a newspaper published in the City of Winterset, Iowa, and by notices of the same posted in three public places in said County of Madison, one of which places being in the same Township in which said property is situated, and one being on the front door of the Court House in said City of Winterset the place where the last District Court of said Madison County was held as required by law, did on the 23<sup>rd</sup> Day of July, A.  one hundred and ninety dollars (\$190) to me in hand  
 paid by the said A. V. Page, the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed  
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey  
 unto the said A. V. Page, his heirs and assigns forever,  
 all of the estate, right title and interest which the said  
 M. D. Martin had on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of April, A. D., 1864, or at  
 any time afterwards, or now has, in and to all the above  
 mentioned property, to have and to hold the said  
 property, and every part thereof, unto the said A. V.  
 Page, his heirs and assigns, forever as fully and absolutely  
 as I, the said H. C. Carter, Sheriff aforesaid, and under  
 the authority aforesaid, might, could or ought to sell and  
 convey the same.
