Know all men by these Presents, That we Jo-  
 siah James - Anna James his wife of Madison  
 County, State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of  
 Four Hundred Dollars in hand paid, do hereby  
 sell and convey, unto William James of Madison  
 County, and State of Iowa the following described  
 premises to wit: West half  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the East half  $\frac{1}{2}$   
 of the North East quarter  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section No Eighteen  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  and the North half of the North East quarter  $\frac{1}{4}$   
 of the South East quarter  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section Seven (7) all  
 in Township Sixty two (62) North of Range Twenty  
 four (24) and we do hereby covenant with the said  
 William James that we are lawfully seized, in  
 fee simple of said premises, that they are free  
 from encumbrance, that we have good right and  
 lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby  
 covenant to warrant and defend the said premises  
 and appurtenances thereto belonging against the  
 lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and  
 the said Anna James hereby relinquishes all her  
 right of dower in and to the above described prem-  
 ises. Signed, the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1864.
