Know all Men by these presents, That the George Fisher and Catharine Fisher his Wife of Delaware County, State of Ohio, in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars in hand paid by Adam Stiffler, do hereby remise, release, and forever quit claim unto the said Adam Stiffler his heirs and assigns forever, all the title, interest, and estate, legal and equitable, in the following premises, with the appurtenances, situate in the county of Madison, in the State of Ohio, and bounded and described as follows: To wit the south east half beginning at the North east corner of Section No thirty four (34) Township No seventy six (76) Range No Twenty six (26) beginning at the above described corner running from thence west eighty rods thence south eighty (80) rods thence East forty (40) rods. Thence North forty (40) rods thence East forty (40) rods thence North forty (40) rods to the place of beginning containing thirty acres be the same more or less.
